

Recommended Qualification Structure for Floorcovering Occupations (Construction) Level 3

This structure has been recommended by employers and stakeholders from the above occupational area for organisations to form the basis of academic capability and competence outcomes. Qualifications with a competence outcome at the above level must have units derived from the following National Occupational Standards (NOS) and consist of the mandatory/optional groups as stated.

MANDATORY

- VR209 v2 Confirm work activities and resources for the work
- VR210 v3 Develop and maintain good working relationships
- VR211 v2 Confirm the occupational method of work
- VR213 v3 Co-ordinate and organise work operations
- VR300 v2 Assess and prepare background surfaces for floorcoverings
- VR301 v2 Prepare and fit underlays for floorcoverings
- VR303 v2 Surface preparation to receive floorcoverings
- VR307 v2 Assess and evaluate conditions for floorcoverings
- VR308 v2 Set out floor areas for specialist designed floorcovering installations
- VR309 v2 Join and repair textile floorcoverings
- VR641 v2 Conform to general workplace health, safety and welfare

Plus optional (one from the following)

- VR310 v2 Install specialist designed resilient or textile floorcoverings
- VR311 v2 Install specialist designed wood and timber-based floorcoverings
