### **Freedom of Information Request 2020-003**

Thank you for contacting CITB requesting information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA). In your request, dated 16 April 2020, you asked the following:

*“Please will you confirm the number of people receiving redundancy money from CITB, over the last 12 months, who had deductions made to Student Loans from the payment.”*

In the 12-month period from 17 April 2019 – 16 April 2020, there was one person that received a redundancy payment from CITB and had a student loan deduction made from it.
